• Once home to the Rockefeller family, <u>The Pocantico Center's</u> verdant campus in the scenic hills of the Hudson Valley just 20 miles north of NYC has been host to some of the most influential leaders, thinkers, and creative minds of the last century. Today, the Rockefeller Brothers Fund continues to bring together people at Pocantico through a robust slate of conferences, artist residencies, tours, performances, exhibitions, and educational programs.

Location

- The Pocantico Center (<u>Map it</u>) 200 Lake Road Tarrytown, NY 10591
- Located 2.3 miles from <u>Tarrytown</u>, and 1.8 miles from <u>Sleepy Hollow</u>.
- Directions to Pocantico from multiple locations are available <u>here</u>.
- Getting to Pocantico from NYC: Take a 40-minute train ride from Grand Central Station to the Tarrytown train station via the Metro-North Hudson line, followed by a 10-minute cab/uber ride.
- Please note: Sleepy Hollow/Tarrytown are not easy to access from Pocantico on foot or bicycle due to hilly, narrow roads with no sidewalks. If the resident(s) don't have a personal vehicle, they will need to arrange taxis/Ubers to get into town.



Seating for up to 12 around the table



Business Center


- Two computers with MS Office software, with high-speed Internet access

Dining Room

- The dining room can accommodate up to 35 guests.
- Each table seats up to seven guests.
- Rearrangement is available for smaller groups.



Automobile Hall

A museum space that contains a collection of antique, vintage, and contemporary automobiles. Located on the first floor of the Coach Barn and utilized as a cocktail reception

Carriage Room

A high-ceilinged museum space with large windows, original glass globe electric chandeliers, and antique carriages. Located on the first floor of the Coach Barn and utilized as a cocktail reception area.







Fitness Equipment

There is an exercise area equipped with a Life Fitness elliptical and a Cybex bicycle for your use on the 1st floor of the Coach Barn.



Hayloft

A comfortable gathering place for after-dinner informal discussions; may also be used as a breakout space.

Accommodations

- Guests are lodged on the second floor of the Coach Barn building.
- . All accommodations have a private bath.
- There are three bedrooms with king sized bed, five with queen sized bed all other rooms have twin sized beds.
- Hair dryers are also provided in each bedroom and adapters are available upon request. Electrical outlets are 115 volts/60 cycles.



Kykuit

- The RBF offers a complimentary tour of Kykuit given by Historic Hudson Valley museum educators.
- Conferees are lodged on the third and fourth floors. There are six bedrooms with king sized bed, four with queen sized bed, all other rooms have twin sized beds.
- Groups can hold a reception on Kykuit Terrace, an outdoor reception area overlooking the Hudson River. Available June-August, weather permitting.

 Available from September to May from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

- Seating for up to 40 around the hollow square table
- Other seating arrangements available if necessary (larger groups than 30 can be accommodated for day meetings)

- Groups can hold a cocktail reception in the gathering space near the gallery or on the exterior terrace; subject to availability.

Frequently Asked Questions

Fees:

 Conference and lodging fees: \$90 per person per diem (includes overnight accommodations, coffee breaks, conference supplies, pads & pens etc)

Meals (all prices include catering labor cost):

- Breakfast: approximately \$20.00 per person (continental breakfast)
- Lunch: approximately \$30.00 per person (one menu per meal)
- Reception & Dinner: approximately \$95.00 per person (one menu per meal)

Organizer selects one menu for the entire group, caterer will select options for those with dietary restrictions.

Spouses/Partners:

 Spouses/partners generally do not attend Pocantico meetings unless they are participating in the meeting themselves.

Children:

Only nursing babies are allowed. (No toddlers/children.)

Service Animals:

 We welcome service animals trained to perform tasks for people with disabilities; please contact our staff in advance of your arrival to ensure proper arrangements. Pets and emotional support animals are not permitted at Pocantico.
